

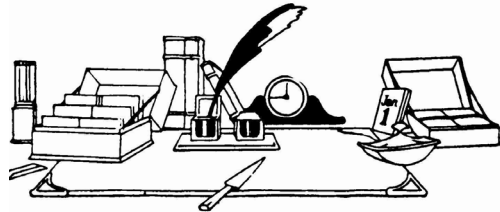

Brighton Voices in Exile

... is a charity which offers support to refugees and exiles in Brighton and surrounding towns. The support offered is of legal advice concerning immigration and refugee status, help with finding accommodation and the problems of settling into a new host country. The charity also maintains a food bank for those with no financial means of support.

The BUC committee believes that many members would be able and glad to support this "Destitution Project". There will be a container in the church vestibule on Sundays to receive gifts and these will be taken regularly to the BVIE food bank. Items which will be particularly useful are non-perishable foods and toiletries. The organizers have sent us the following list:
