A unique part of Brighton's heritage

Our elegant, Grade 2 listed building was completed in 1820 on land bought from the Prince Regent. The architect Amon Henry Wilds designed much of Regency Brighton. Our columns and steps are a well-known Brighton landmark.

A community resource

The church is a meeting place for many community groups and charities. We are proud to host groups such as Brighton and Hove Gay Men's Chorus, Marijuana Anonymous and the Carousel Singers, a choir of singers with learning disabilities. The Montessori nursery is a long-term user of the church hall.

A cultural space

The church is a concert venue with a unique atmosphere. Its central location and excellent acoustics make it popular with classical and contemporary musicians and all kinds of performers and artists.

A place for rites of passage

We provide weddings, including samesex weddings, child-naming ceremonies and funerals. We can arrange ceremonies for people of all faiths and none, drawing on their own beliefs and values.
