

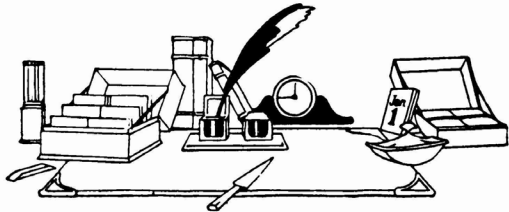

Working on our Welcome: Improving Our Hospitality to LGBTQ+ People...

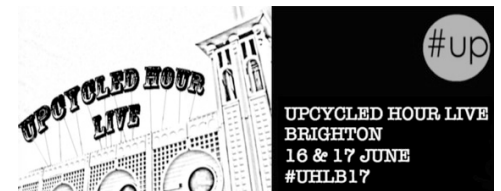
